

HOW TO ENTER YOUR PHOTOS ON PHOTOVAULT:

Please note that only members whose club fees are paid up may enter photos.

Normal submission rules apply:

Entries per person: 4 (Max 2 images per category)

Bonus entry: You may enter a 5th entry but it must be a print (but still max 2 images per category)

Every print must be clearly marked on the reverse side at the bottom left hand corner with the authors' name, photo title, category and star level.

Prints must be mounted on a mounting board.

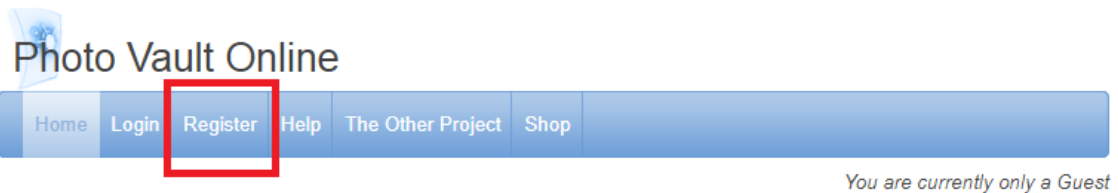
Print size may not be less than 203 x 254 mm (8" x 10") or, including the mount, more than 406 x 508 mm (16" x 20").

Prints must be submitted together with an entry form 15 minutes before the published start time of the meeting.

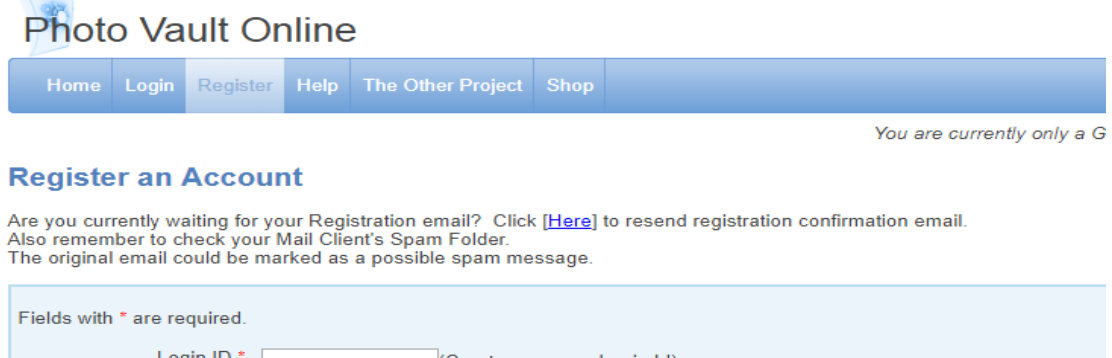
You must have a valid email address before starting the registration process on PhotoVault.

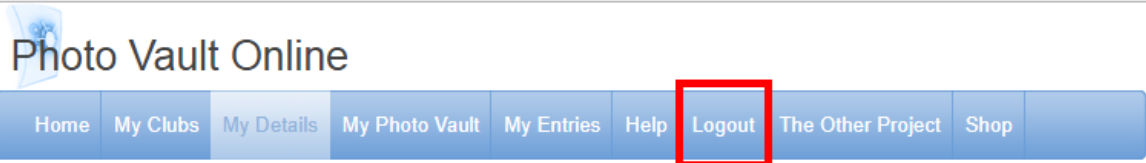

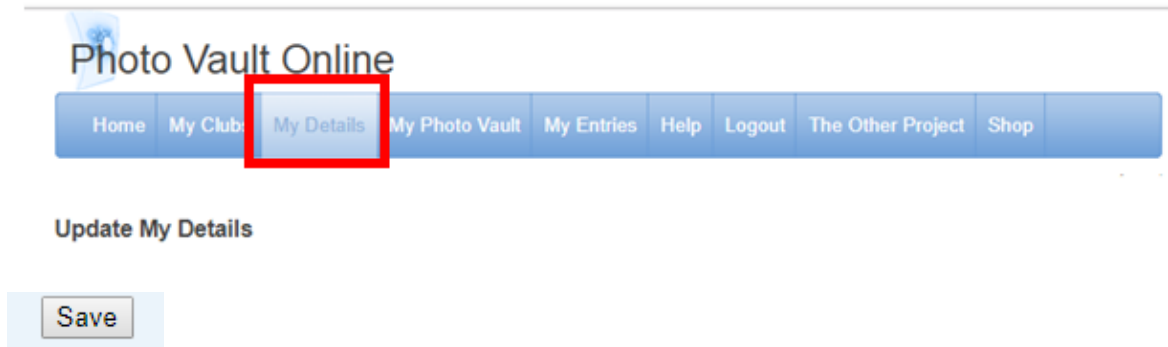

DEFINITIONS OF CATEGORIES:

1. **DOCUMENTARY PHOTOGRAPHY**

Including Photojournalism, Photo Travel, Sport and Street Photography.

Photojournalism:

An image that tell a news story. Photojournalism is distinguished from other close branches of photography by the qualities of timeliness. The images have meaning in the context of a recently published record of events.

Objectivity – the situation implied by the images is a fair and accurate representation of the events they depict in both content and tone.

Narrative - the image combine with other news elements to make facts relatable to the viewer or reader on a cultural level.

Photo Travel:

Defines a travel photo as an image that expresses the feeling of a time and place, portrays a land, its people, or a culture in its natural state, and has no geographical limitations.

Sports Photography:

Covers any aspect of a sporting event. Images must depict an active pastime or recreation involving physical exertion and/ or skill that is governed by a set of rules or customs and often of a competitive nature. Images in this section could include, for instance, the judge or umpire in a sporting event.

Street Photography:

Also sometimes called candid photography – is photography conducted for art or enquiry that features unmediated chance encounters and random incidents within public places.

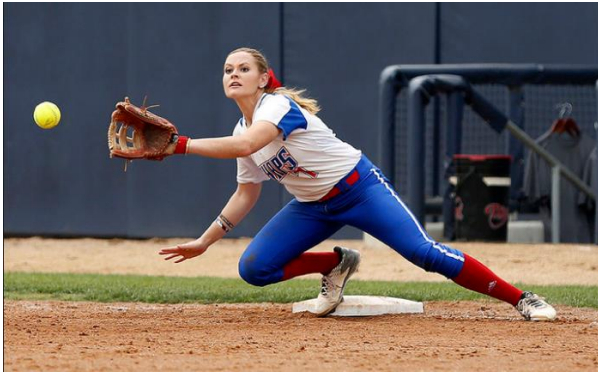

2. OPEN

Open including Pictorial:

Images with wide visual appeal. Any subject that is treated pictorially, embodying the elements of good design, arrangement or composition, which reflects the personal interpretation of the photographer also **including Visual Art, Altered Reality and Avant-garde** photography as a means of expression and as a vehicle for the definition for Visual Art / Altered Reality and Avant-garde is that these images should go beyond the straightforward pictorial rendering of a scene.

3. PORTRAITURE:

Portraiture – Human portraiture only including full length, head and shoulders, body parts.

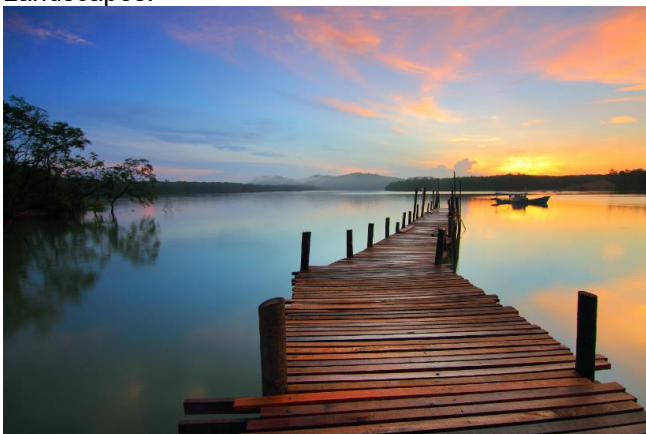

4. SCAPES

Scape including landscapes, Seascapes and Cityscapes.

5. NATURE:

Nature photography is restricted to the use of the photographic process to depict observations from all branches of natural history, except anthropology and archaeology, in such a fashion that a well-informed person will be able to identify the subject material and to certify as to its honest presentation.

- NO human elements shall not be present
- The presence of scientific bands on wild animals is acceptable
- Photographs of artificially produced hybrid plants or animals, domestic and farm animals, mounted specimens, or obviously set arrangements, are ineligible, as is any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement. Manipulation includes but is not limited to removing or adding any element by means other than cropping.
- The faithful representation of what was captured at the time of shooting must be maintained. Digital & printing adjustments are only acceptable if limited to levels, curves, colour, saturation and contrast work, dodging and burning, Sharpening allowed.
- Compositing, multiple exposure, sandwich/montages shots and double exposures are not permitted, except the new digital technique such as HDR and stacking to represent the true nature of the object at the time of shooting.
